We block lanes to provide a safe lane change for the bikes and now have rotating yellow caution lights for our vehicles as well as radio communication with other riders in our group, magnetic signs and flags for the cars.

Besides providing a chase car, we support our chapter by making ourselves available to help with various functions, such as cooking, helping on fundraisers and we take pictures of the group on the road that could never be obtained otherwise.

We earn the right to wear the vest with "Support Team" on the back. This is not just handed out. The ALR members vote every six months, as to who may wear this patch. If you are interested in becoming a support team member, just contact any ALR member and come out to support them and have fun doing it. Seeing the benefits, some of the other chapters in our area are now looking at establishing their own support teams. We are "setting the bar"!!!!!!
